ASUR Announces Total Passenger Traffic Up 13.2 Percent Year-over-Year

Mexico City, May 5, 2003, Grupo Aeroportuario del Sureste, S.A. de C.V. (NYSE: ASR; BMV: ASUR) (ASUR) today announced that total passenger traffic for the month of April 2003 increased by 13.2 percent from the comparable period last year.

Due to the current situation following the events of September 11, 2001, in the U.S. and the start of the armed conflict in the Middle East, ASUR's management is making an extraordinary effort to publish passenger traffic figures for the company's airports on a monthly basis to keep investors well informed. Once the situation has normalized, ASUR management expects to return to normal quarterly reporting procedures.

All figures in this announcement reflect comparisons between the 28-day period from April 2 through April 29, 2003, and the equivalent 28-day period last year from April 3 through April 30, 2002. Transit and general aviation passengers are excluded.

By week, ASUR's total passenger traffic from April 2 through April 29, 2003 varied year-over-year as follows:

- Decreased by 10.0 percent for the seven-day period from April 2 through 8;
- Increased by 18.1 percent for the seven-day period from April 9 through 15;
- Increased by 25.2 percent for the seven-day period from April 16 through 22 and
- Increased by 23.3 percent for the seven-day period from April 23 through 29.
