

Privacy Policy

At Grupo Aeroportuario del Sureste, S.A.B. de C.V. ("ASUR"), we recognize the importance of correctly handling the personal data of the people that we come into contact with, either by electronic means or in the processes relating to the operation of our airports.

This Privacy Policy applies to the all personal data obtained by Grupo Aeroportuario del Sureste and its subsidiaries, and provides information on the treatment given to all such data, as well as the applicable security measures.

Collection and Processing of Personal Data

ASUR may collect personal data from a variety of sources, such as when ASUR issues airport identification badges or enters into an employment contract, or in other similar situations.

In general, ASUR does not request personal data of a sensitive nature. However, on occasion and in certain circumstances, data of this kind may be requested or otherwise obtained. In such cases, it is understood that you provide such data with informed consent.

Purpose of Handling Personal Data

ASUR collects, uses, stores or transfers personal data, insofar as this is permissible by law, for the purpose of the administration of its airports and its human resources. Instances in which personal data may be handled include: issuing airport identification badges, compliance with the Airport Security Plan established in accordance with the provisions of the Airport Law [*Ley de Aeropuertos*], and compliance with the company's obligations as an employer under the relevant legislation, among others.

ASUR may use personal data for other purposes similar to those mentioned above, which are compatible with the same objectives. Personal data may be handled for as long as is necessary, in accordance with the applicable legal provisions.

Security Measures

ASUR has adopted technical, administrative and physical security measures to safeguard personal data and to avoid the damage, loss, alteration or destruction thereof, as well as any unauthorized use, access or handling. Only authorized staff members, who are trained in and adhere to confidentiality requirements, may handle personal data. They are prohibited from providing access to unauthorized persons and from using personal data for purposes other than those described above.

Communication and Transfer of Personal Data

In the course of normal business operations, as well as to comply with the applicable legal provisions, ASUR may share some personal data with third parties. ASUR will not assign, sell or transfer your personal data to third parties that are unrelated to ASUR without your prior consent.

Rights of the owner of personal data
